DSU overview, presidential search update



Rotarian and Acting DSU President Ty Orton spoke last week, saying enrollment is up to 1,450 students. He detailed upcoming and current projects on campus, such as hiring a nursing director so plans for the nursing program can be in place in 2025 move forward. Footings near the Ag/Rodeo Complex will appear next month and we will see parking lot improvements. In seeking a leader for the students and 160 staff, Orton said the State Board of Higher Education plans to appoint an interim president on September 24. That person will serve for up to nine months while the board conducts its search for a new DSU president. The current plan calls for the individual selected to begin duties on June 1st.
