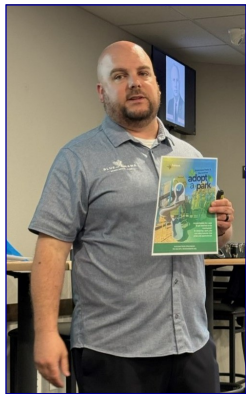
Preview of the upcoming new Rotary year, President-Elect Joy Schoch
